The Guild accepts donations of fabric and sewing supplies, but no longer accepts scraps for stuffing as the requirements for animal beds have changed.

If you want to donate a quilt for a specific purpose, please let us know. Requirements for the quilts vary.

Infants:	Layette/Crib-size 36"x42" up to 42"x54"
Children	36"x42" up to 48"x60" (a few twin size 60"x80" can be used)
Wheelchair:	40"x40" (must be quilted, not tied)
Anyone:	42"x60" up to 54"x72"

Please note: All quilts for institutional use must be washed every week. Quilting wears much better than tied quilts.
